But, a lot of the time, Mummy and Daddy talk about how all the shelves were empty at the shops that morning.






Now that worries me.




But, sometimes, people buy a bit more than they really need...

And that's why some shelves at the shops are completely empty. But, fortunately, every day new products are delivered to the shops...




... which are made every day in lots of factories...

... and produced by farmers...




... caught by fishermen ...
