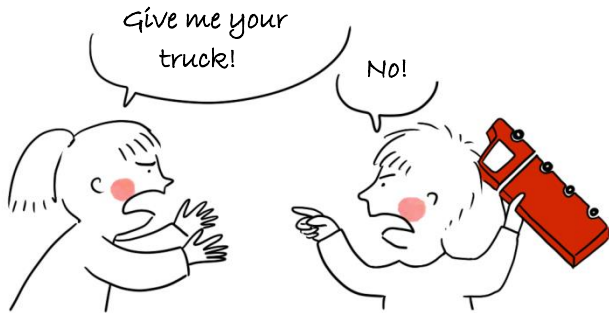


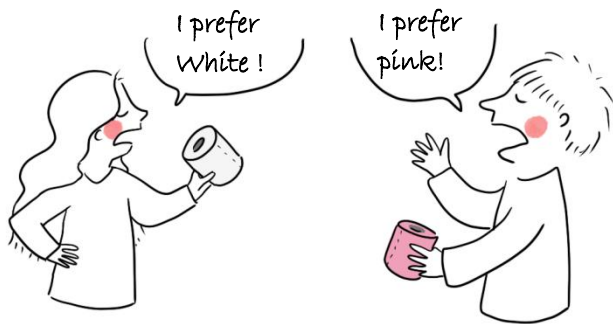
# Cocovirus

This has never happened before.

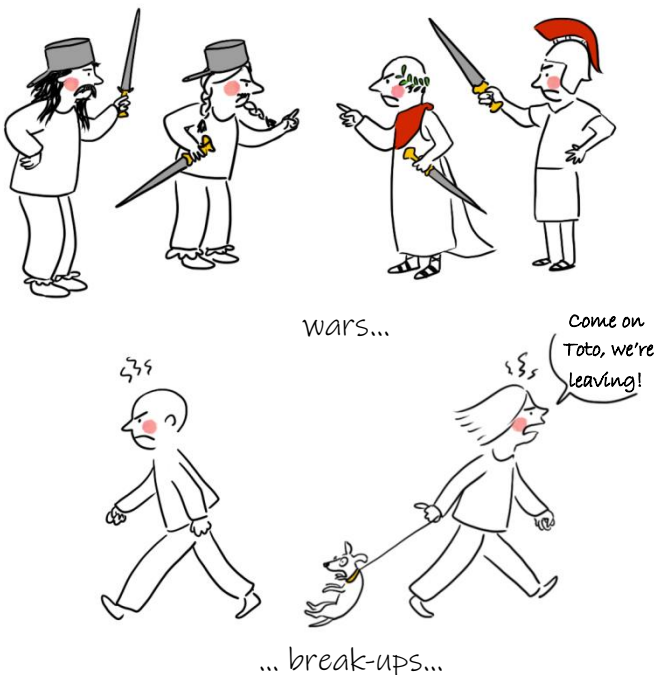
You must know people who can never get along with others...



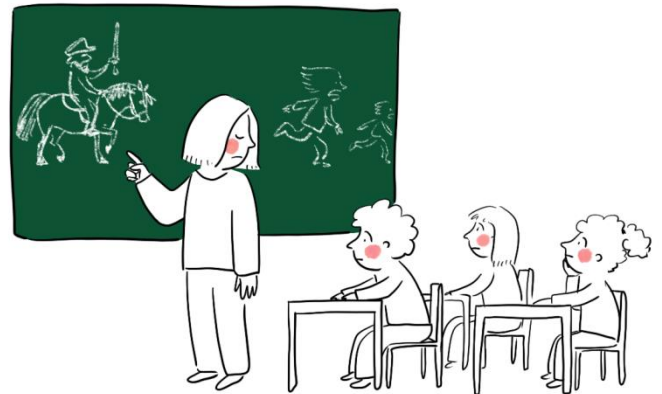
... or who have different opinions to each other.



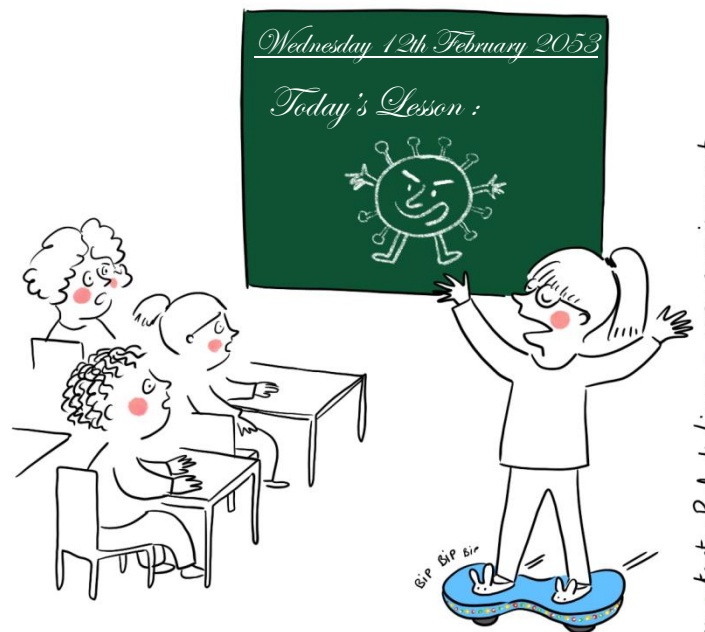
It's just like that. But often in the past, and even nowadays, these disagreements have led to terrible situations:

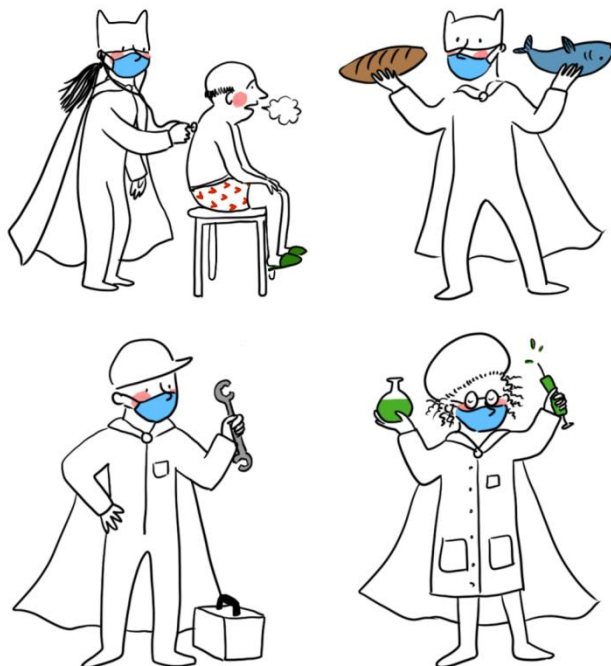
They will say that, for the first time, the enemy wasn't someone we didn't get along with, or didn't have the same opinion as, but this tiny thing, invisible to the naked eye.



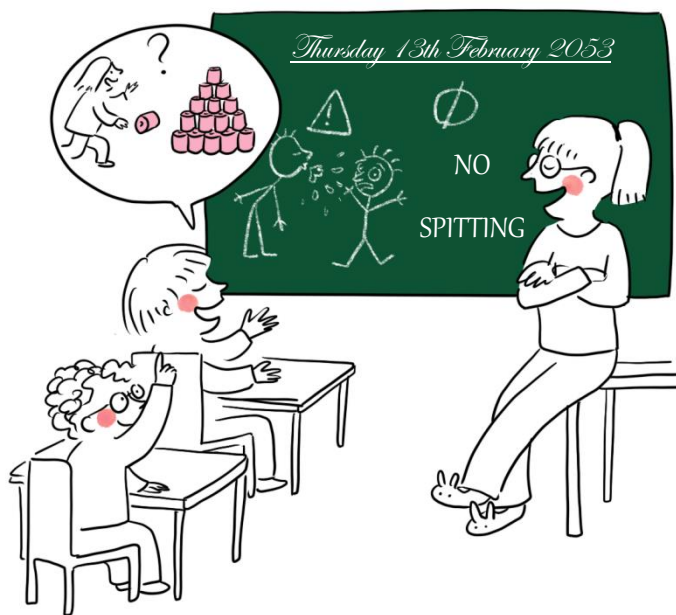
They will say that, for the first time, every country in the world fought together against the same enemy.
