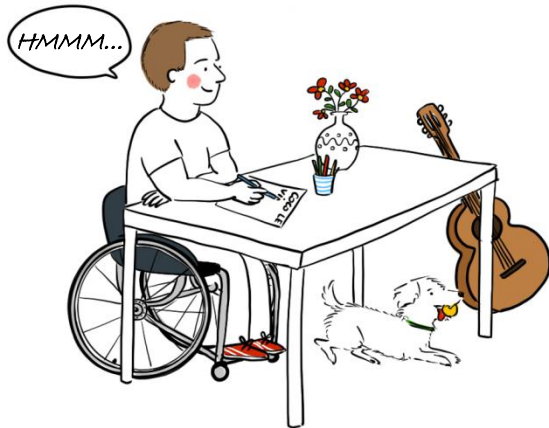




the coronavirus explained to

Coco the Virus is a comic book created by Paul, he writes all the stories...



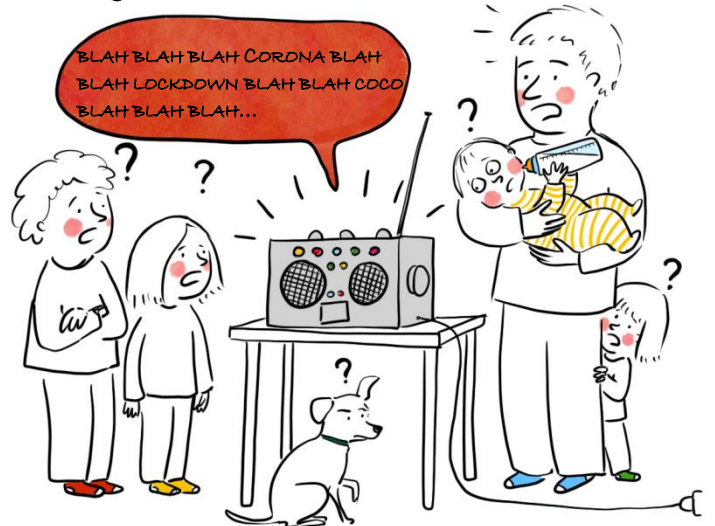
...then, he sends the stories to Marguerite, his younger sister, who's in charge of making all the drawings.

Ever since the early stages of cocoonfinement, they've been trying to help families out by posting 5 stories each week on a bunch of different topics.

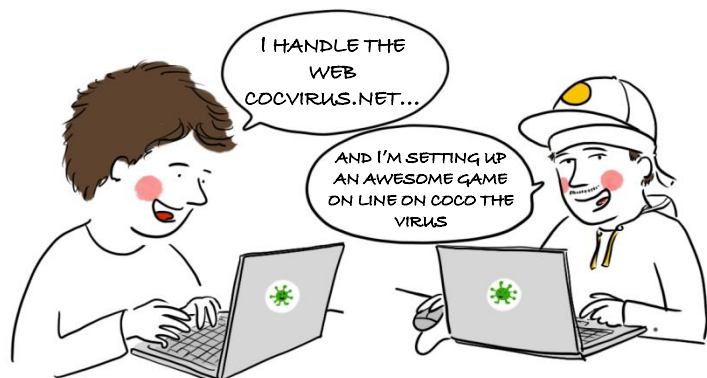


They're really happy to see that children and grown-ups alike are enjoying their stories so much!

...as well as two dozen or so amazing volunteers who translate the comic books...

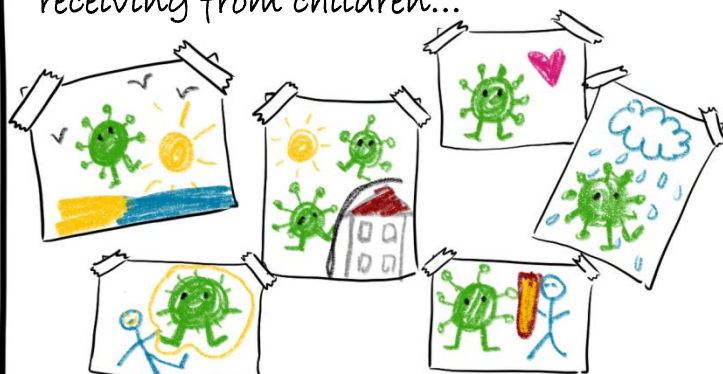


...and let's not forget about all those who talk about Coco the Virus to spread the word.
