## *Pompom Loco*

Make your own nasty Coco, with a bit of yarn and cardboard...



### Material

- light cardboard
- yarn
- markers
- sharp scissors
- liquid glue or glue gun

### Instructions





Using a glass, draw two circles on the cardboard. Draw a smaller circle in the middle, about 3 cm. You can also use the template (see next page).

Cut out the circles.



Cut a slit and cut out the middle circle

Align the circles, and wrap the yarn around it, until the middle circle is almost filled **(1)**. Cut carefully, passing the scissors between the two circles of cardboard **(2)**. Pass a wire between the two circles, and make a double knot all around the strands, tightening very hard **(3)**. You can now remove the circles.



Your pom-pom is ready to become Coco: cut out the different elements in light cardboard and stick them on the pom-pom with liquid glue or the glue gun. You can use the template to draw the elements.
